## Changing room Code of Conduct

### Introduction

The changing room is an essential area, and it is important that all members and visitors use this space respectfully and responsibly. A well-managed and maintained changing room ensures that everyone can enjoy their experience in a safe, secure, and comfortable environment.

To ensure that the changing room is a welcoming and safe space for everyone, Hazelwood has developed a code of conduct that outlines the expected behaviour and responsibilities of all individuals who use this facility. This code of conduct applies to all members, visitors, coaches, and officials who use the changing room, and it is an integral part of our commitment to promoting a safe and inclusive environment.

This code of conduct provides guidelines to ensure that everyone using the changing room is treated with respect and dignity, and that the changing room is always kept clean and tidy. It is important that everyone using the changing room is aware of these guidelines and follows them, so that we can maintain a positive and respectful environment for all.

The purpose of this code of conduct is to promote a culture of mutual respect, responsibility, and safety in our changing room. We ask all members and visitors to take the time to read and understand this code of conduct, and to actively contribute to creating a safe, welcoming, and enjoyable experience for all who use our changing room.

### Code of Conduct

1. The changing rooms are available for use by all members of the club.
2. Changing rooms are provided for the convenience of members who wish to change clothes or store their personal belongings before, during, or after their workout.
3. Members should keep the changing rooms always clean and tidy. Please do not leave personal belongings in the changing rooms when you are not using them.
4. The club is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please do not leave valuables in the changing rooms.
5. Members are expected to always wear appropriate clothing in the changing rooms. Please do not change clothes in public areas.

6. The use of cameras or any recording devices in the changing rooms is strictly prohibited.
7. Members should report any maintenance or hygiene issues to a staff member or management immediately.
8. The changing rooms will be closed at the end of each day, and any items left behind will be removed and disposed of.
9. The club reserves the right to refuse access to the changing rooms to any member who violates this policy or behaves in an inappropriate manner.
